For the 2014 AP Exams, the cost is \$95.00 per exam.

Free and reduced lunch student exam fees are \$25.00

Students must answer all of the questions on the on-line registration form in order to complete the exam registration. **A confirmation page indicates that the exam registration process has been successfully completed.**
